About you

SST is seeking a registered nurse (RN) to provide shift clinical leadership, you will be working a rotating roster of morning and afternoon shifts including weekends. SST has an experienced RN who will provide support and guidance.

About the role

This role primarily focuses on the crisis respite unit which provides short term residential support for up to 13 people experiencing mental distress that do not require admission to CDHB acute units.

The key responsibilities:

- assessing referrals for admission and completing admission requirements.
- Planning, and providing clinical support to implement, to meet each person's health care needs including mental distress
- provide direction and support to unregistered staff
- overseeing medication management including training and assessing unregistered staff to administer.
- to provide on-call services when on shift, and on a shared roster, that includes covering the other SST residential houses.
- able to work with the values and customs of the SST organisation.

Nursing experience requirements are:

- A current NZ practicing certificate
- Experience responding to health status changes
- Providing direction and support to unregistered staff.
- Using electronic patient management systems

Preference will be given to a RN with experience in:

- Working with people experiencing mental distress
- Understanding the recovery approach
- Flexibility and adaptability to provide services to people with a range of support needs.
- Experience within the field of alcohol and other drug abuse/addiction.
