This role provides clinical oversight of our 24/7 12 bed youth residential service to assist staff implement and maintain high service standards.

Are you a registered Social Worker or Nurse with sound experience and looking for a step up to extend your clinical experience; wanting a new challenge?

Do you have at least 3 years' experience with youth in a mental health or AOD context – preferably with at least 2 years' experience in residential work?

Are you passionate about working with at risk young people and able to champion best practice work models for them; as well as lead the professional practice of staff?

The role will include the following key components:

- Liaison with other agencies - collaboration with SMHS, GPs, Schools etc
- Responding to referrals and enquiries
- Clinical leadership of staff to provide assessment, planning, structure, advice, support and direction to achieve their young persons' therapeutic plans, and navigation to other services
- Ensure the residential living environment functions smoothly and is an effective tool to assist the service's recovery focus
- Some weekday evenings and weekend work, including sharing wider organisation on call responsibilities
- Pay Scale range \$65k to \$75k per annum for 1.0 FTE equivalent.
