We are looking for a person who is energetic and enthusiastic, who is committed to the wellbeing of children and young people where mental illness exists in a parent.

At Stepping Stone Trust we offer a supportive working environment, professional development opportunities and the chance to be part of a team that is dedicated, passionate and highly competent.

The successful candidates will be able to demonstrate the following competencies, abilities and attributes:

- Strong assessment skills
- Ability to engage and develop good relationships with children, young people, and families
- Effective group working skills especially with children and parents
- Be able to contribute in a multi-disciplinary team setting
- Understand, and have the ability and willingness to work cross culturally and commitment to the principles of Treaty of Waitangi

You need a full New Zealand driver's license, computer literacy, an attention to detail and the ability to work in an inter-agency collaborative setting.

The role would ideally suit a person with a Level 4 Certificate in Health and Wellbeing or equivalent (please check the Careerforce website to see if your qualification has equivalency). This could also include recent graduates.

The role is due to start mid-January 2019 and the pay range is \$41k to 51k per annum for 1.0 FTE (\$19.80 to \$24.50 per hour) in line with gender pay equity.
